Founded as the first law center in the nation dedicated solely to serving the legal needs of sexual assault and rape victims, the Victim Rights Law Center's (VRLC) mission is to ensure that every sexual assault victim has an attorney and the most effective legal remedies available.

The VRLC provides:

- Free legal services to rape and sexual assault victims in Massachusetts in the areas of their lives that the assault has impacted, including privacy, safety, housing, employment, immigration, education, and finances.
- Training for lawyers and advocates nationwide on how to represent and advocate for victims in the legal areas above.

We have a variety of internship opportunities available to students depending on interest and experience, including:

- **Client Services**
Interns may conduct legal intakes with victims and assist staff attorneys with providing legal services to clients.
- **Research**
Interns may do research on how to use existing law creatively to access remedies for our clients. We welcome interns interested in researching the cutting edge legal issues that survivors face in the aftermath of a sexual assault.
- **Special Projects**
The VRLC is involved with various ongoing discrete projects on which interns could work, including initiatives focused on representing victims of sexual assault who are minors, mentally or physically disabled, LGBTQ, and/or immigrants.
